

**Agreement for Inter-district Cooperative Educational Services
2009 - 2010 Extended School Year (ESY) Program**

This agreement is hereby entered into by and between the Sedro-Woolley School District No. 101, Skagit County No. 29, Washington, which is hereinafter referred to as the “**servicing district**” and the Concrete School District No. 011, Skagit County No. 29, Washington, hereinafter referred to as the “**participating district.**”


The purpose of this agreement is to utilize inter-district cooperation, authorized by RCW 28A.335.160, RCW 28A.225.250, and Chapter 392-135 WAC, to support parental school choice, pursuant to RCW 28A.225 and Chapter 392-173 WAC, by providing educational programs not otherwise available or suitable, and to avoid duplications of specialized programs and facilities. These objectives will be achieved by the following described cooperative program:

The Sedro-Woolley School District will provide an appropriate extended school year program for identified student(s) from the participating district consistent with each student’s Individual Education Plan and the rules and regulations of the State of Washington. This education will be provided within existing district programs, so long as those programs continue to be offered by Sedro-Woolley and so long as the student complies with the rules of conduct for the program. Transportation of students to and from facilities where program services are located will be the responsibility of the participating district and shall be provided in such a manner as they consider appropriate.

The estimated cost for serving two students, **Anwar Towner and Alex Harp**, is estimated to be \$1,261.56, each, the total being \$2,523.12, to be billed in a single invoice at the end of the program in July 2010.

Services will include a 1:1 classroom staffing ratio, as required, including therapy services by a licensed Occupational Therapist and a Speech/language aide.


