EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM CONTRACT 2018-2019
INFANT TODDLER/PARENT EDUCATION**

IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between the Concrete School District of Skagit County, State of Washington, hereinafter called the District, and Skagit Preschool and Resource Center called Contractor, that the contractor shall perform those duties as hereinafter described.

SAID CONTRACTOR AGREES TO:

- Consult with parents, other service providers, and representatives of appropriate community agencies to ensure the effective coordination and provision of early intervention services in the Concrete School District including child find for early identification and referral.
- Providing Family Resources Coordination for eligible children in the Concrete School District.
- Providing early intervention evaluations and assessments for eligible children in the Concrete School District.
- Provide educational/therapeutic services for eligible children as outlined on the Individual Service Plan (IFSP).
- Providing all early intervention services as outlined on the Individualized Family Service Plans (IFSP) for children ages birth through two in the Concrete School District in accordance with applicable state and federal special education requirements.
- Training parents and others regarding the provision of those services.
- Participating in the multidisciplinary team's assessment of a child and the child's family, and in the development of integrated criteria and outcomes for the Individualized Family Service Plan to include procedural safeguards, parent rights information and transition activities/plan to preschool special education or other appropriate services.
- Completing the Child Outcome Summary Form (COS) with families at the initial IFSP and at the time of transition as appropriate.
- Utilize the statewide electronic ESIT Data Management System, including the statewide IFSP format, and the Child Outcome Summary Form (COS) to facilitate accurate countywide documentation of early intervention services.

SPARC WILL:

- Provide a copy of the Early Childhood Specialist/Therapist qualifications and job descriptions will be forwarded to the District on request.
- Participate in meetings with the District Coordinator of Special Programs to monitor the efficacy of the program and services being rendered, as needed.
- Facilitate training of the Parent/Infant Educator (Early Childhood Specialist) pertaining to the use of appropriate assessment instruments and educational service methodology.

THE TERM of this contract shall be from September 2018 through June 2019.

THE CONTRACTOR will be paid at a rate of \$735.00 a month, per qualified child: said payments will be made by check in accordance with the District's payment policy.


THE CONTRACTOR will provide a monthly statement including the names of children served after IFSP is in place, the kind of services provided and the number of hours required to perform said services. (copy of child's monthly attendance sheet)

THROUGHOUT THE term of this contract, Contractor shall be subject to School Board policies and administrative rules and regulations.

THE CONTRACT may be altered only upon mutual consent of the Board of Directors of the Concrete School District and Executive Director of SPARC.
