

**SKAGIT PRESCHOOL AND RESOURCE CENTER

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM CONTRACT 2011-2012
INFANT TODDLER/PARENT EDUCATION**

IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between the Concrete School District of Skagit County, State of Washington, hereinafter called the District, and Skagit Preschool and Resource Center called Contractor, that the contractor shall perform those duties as hereinafter described.

SAID CONTRACTOR AGREES TO:

1. Employ an Early Childhood Specialist/Therapist for the explicit purpose of rendering services as a Parent/Infant Educator to Developmentally Delayed Infants/Toddlers (Birth to Three) residing in the district. Services shall be provided in the home or other natural environment and will include a minimum of three, forty-five minute sessions per month. A copy of the Early Childhood Specialist/Therapist qualifications and job descriptions will be forwarded to the District on request.
2. Facilitate training of the Parent/Infant Educator (Early Childhood Specialist) pertaining to the use of appropriate assessment instruments and educational service methodology. Specialist will be included in pertinent District training sessions.
3. Provide supervision of the Parent/Infant Educator in the manner prescribed by applicable statutes, rules and regulations.
4. Participate in Quarterly meetings with the District Coordinator of Special Programs to monitor the efficacy of the program and services being rendered.
5. Carry out the specially designed instruction developed jointly by Contractor, District and parent/guardian as defined in the Individual Family Service Plan and in accordance with applicable state and federal special education requirements.

THE TERM of this contract shall be from September 2011 through June 2012.


THE CONTRACTOR will be paid at a rate of \$450.00 a month, per qualified child: said payments will be made by check in accordance with the District's payment policy.


THE CONTRACTOR will provide a monthly statement including the names of children served after IFSP is in place, the kind of services provided and the number of hours required to perform said services. (copy of child's monthly attendance sheet)

THROUGHOUT THE term of this contract, Contractor shall be subject to School Board policies and administrative rules and regulations.

THE CONTRACT may be altered only upon mutual consent of the Board of Directors of the Concrete School District and Executive Director of SPARC.
